The need in our community is urgent:

- In the United States, 1 in 3 women and 1 in 4 men will be physically assaulted by an intimate partner at some point in their lives
- In California, an average of 124 women per year are murdered at the hands of an intimate partner. In 76% of the cases involving a history of violence, family, friends or co-workers were aware of the abuse.
- 60% of children exposed to domestic violence are also direct victims of abuse, injury, or neglect.

## How Your Partnership Makes a Difference

The consequences of domestic and sexual violence extend far beyond individual trauma. They impact our community's overall health, safety, and economic stability. Those experiencing domestic or sexual abuse are more likely to experience homelessness, mental health issues, and financial hardship.

By partnering with NEWS, your company demonstrates a commitment to social responsibility and a safer community. Your support directly enables us to:

**Provide essential services** 24-hour Help Line and response team, emergency shelter, food, and clothing. Crisis counseling, legal advocacy, and support groups to survivors and children.

**Empower survivors** Help individuals rebuild their lives in transitional housing and achieve self-sufficiency through case management and ongoing advocacy.

**Prevent future violence** Prevention and education programs to educate youth and the community about healthy relationships and violence prevention through our children and youth programs, and participating in community events.

**Your Partnership will save lives**  
**\$2,500** Provides legal consultation fees for 10 survivors of DV/SA.

**\$5,000** Ensures a survivor remains safely housed, covering one deposit and first month's rent.

**\$10,000** Can cover one-year of emergency financial assistance for approximately 50 DV/SA survivors in Napa County.

**\$15,000** Covers one-year of support groups for adults and children to gain emotional and mental health support as they process their trauma.

**\$25,000** Support staffing, allowing NEWS to remain fully staffed to continue to spread awareness through our programs, helping the community END violence and allowing survivors to have round-the-clock support from our advocates to live a life FREE of violence.
